




Five Years Waiting

 Inconspicuously nestled in the rolling hills of Woodbury sits **HOGPEN HILL FARMS**, the private property of artist, writer, statistician, and former Yale professor Edward Tufte. For the first time in five years, Tufte will be hosting two open house weekends on October 5-6 and 10-11, where visitors can take a tour of his incredible property, home to his unique sculptures.

Since the last open house in 2014, which was attended by over 3,000 visitors, Tufte has completed his newest book, *Seeing With Fresh Eyes: Meaning, Space, Models, Data, Truth*, and added several new sculptures to the land. Tufte expressed the absolute autonomy he feels when creating art for his property, declaring, "The only limitation there is with sculpture is gravity." The property contains a range of large sculptures made from stone, steel, aluminum, plastic, and even bamboo including an 84 foot long sculpture of steel attached to a floating Airstream.

Tufte believes that art is there for people to appreciate, and little else; this is embodied by a sequence of three philosophical signs along the winding drive-way that read, "Art is Art"... "And Everything Else"... "Is Everything Else". Mr Tufte hopes you will attend the open house with this mantra in mind.
